



2007 Tadpole Shiraz

The Tadpole Shiraz is an untamed animal - zero filtration, zero fining and minimal intervention.

In 2007, we experienced one of the driest years on record. We anticipated that the flavours would be achieved very early in vintage and consequently we picked all of our Shiraz by the first week of March. This has resulted in a wine that exhibits extraordinary balance and integration in its youth.

Aged primarily in American oak barriques for 14 months, the Tadpole is wine that you dream of - natural, juicy, soft and drinkable.

Colour: Purple, black.

Nose: Cassis, boysenberry, brambly, cinnamon, crème brûlée and smoky oak.

Palate: A powerful wine that is rich yet restrained. The front palate shows characteristics of raspberry conserve and spice. The mid to back palate is dominated by red fruits combined with soft creamy oak and tannin - wonderful balance for a youthful wine, showcasing creativity at its best.

Cellar: Drink now - 6 years.
