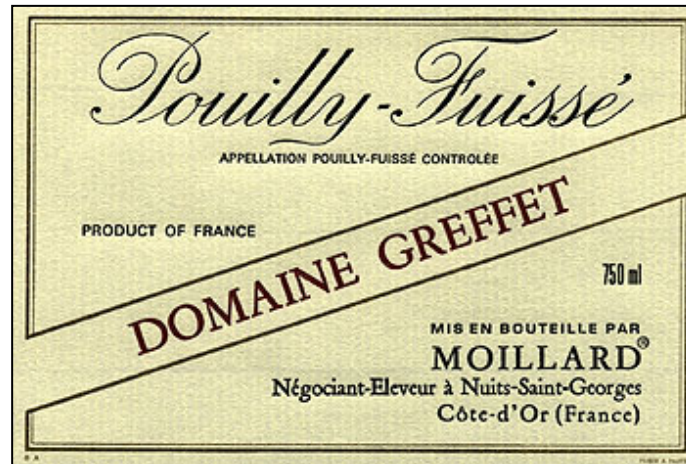


Pouilly-Fuissé Domaine Greffet

White



► Location

The vineyards producing Pouilly-Fuissé are scattered over the communes of Fuissé, Pouilly, Solutré, Vergisson and Chaintré. They are situated on the hills west of Mâcon.

► Grape variety

Chardonnay.

► Production

From approximately 850 hectares (2125 acres), the yearly yield is 4 or 5 million bottles of white wine.

► Characteristics

The wines of Pouilly are a delight for both the eyes and the palate. Of a golden colour, they are dry, caressing and as vigorous as the best Burgundy wines. The winegrower does not sell his Pouilly-Fuissé, he agrees to part with his wine ("il s'en sépare...").

► Gastronomy

This wine goes well with seafood, with or without sauce.

► Serving temperature

It should be drunk cool, but not chilled. The ideal temperature is that of the wine-cellar (11-14°C).

► History

Fuissé probably comes from the Germanic word "top" (faite).
