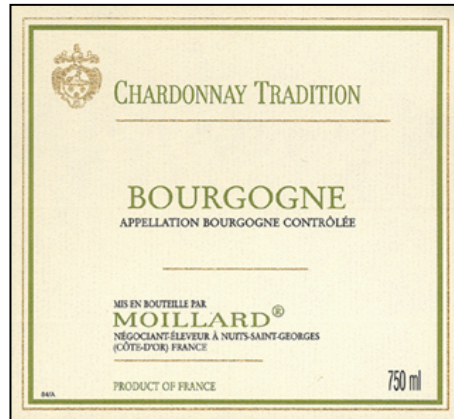


# Bourgogne Chardonnay Tradition

## ► Location

Bourgogne Chardonnay can be produced all over Burgundy : Côte de Nuits, Côte de Beaune, Hautes-Côtes, Côte Chalonnaise and Chablis. It is the result of rigorous selection taking place at harvest time.

## ► Grape variety

Chardonnay.

## ► Production

The production of white Burgundy is about 4 million bottles per year.

## ► Characteristics

Like all great white Burgundies, it comes from the grape variety Chardonnay. The Chardonnay vines are grown on a limestone soil, producing perfumed wines with flower aromas. They are intense and refined.

## ► Gastronomy

This wine, rich in alcohol, vigorous and with an amber colour has hints of cinnamon, fresh walnuts and pepper. It is perfect for gastronomic meals and it is marvellous with fish, terrine and cheese.

## ► Serving temperature

Serve at cellar temperature : 12°C.

## ► History

More than a thousand years ago, the Cistercian monks had already selected the best grape varieties for the great white Burgundies. They only allowed the Chardonnay and the Pinot Blanc.
